WorkReady Students may be eligible for a concession if they are:

- > A current Commonwealth Government concession card holder:
 - > Health Care Card; or
 - > Pensioner Concession Card; or
 - > Veteran Affairs Concession Card.
- > A prisoner in a South Australian correctional institution.
